2d Marine Division Staff Judge Advocate is seeking applicants for Active-Duty Operational Support (ADOS) orders to serve as an Assistant Staff Judge Advocate in Camp Lejeune, NC.

Requirements:

Rank: O4 / Major (will consider one rank up/down)

Billet: Assistant Staff Judge Advocate

Clearance Level: Secret

Start and End Dates / Duration: 1 - 3 months of ADOS available, between May and August 2025.

Location: Camp Lejeune, NC

Billet Overview:

Provides legal support to nearly 20 commanding officers, with courts-martial convening authority, along with their staffs at the Division, Regiment, and Battalion levels. Assistance with military justice issues, providing critical support to ongoing cases and helping to manage the high volume of legal matters within the Division. Provides flexibility to support operational requirements during this period without degradation of legal support to the command and their staff. Ensures that all legal matters are handled with the necessary accuracy and timeliness, preserving the legal readiness and operational effectiveness of the 2d MarDiv.

Qualifications:

- Proven expertise in exercise planning and execution at the battalion level, with a focus on full portfolio of judge advocate activities, e.g., military justice, admin. law, ethics, operational law, etc.
- Strong analytical skills with the ability to develop effective solutions in dynamic and high-pressure situations.
- Exceptional communication and interpersonal skills, facilitating collaboration among diverse teams.
- Ability to handle a diverse and fast-paced environment.

Remarks:

The 2d Marine Division Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (OSJA) is one of the busiest shops within the Marine Corps, with over 13,000 Marines, sailors, and DoD civilians. At the present, the OSJA is composed of four active-duty judge advocates, two Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA) judge advocates, and five active-duty enlisted legal support specialists.
