Position Description / Requirements: Marine Forces Special Operations Command (MARFORSOC) is the Marine service component to U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM). A judge advocate within MARFORSOC can be expected to handle a host of legally complex issues in the areas of military justice, international law, fiscal, cyber and intelligence law, ethics, and administrative law, along with a whole host of other mission-dependent requirements. A judge advocate at MARFORSOC needs to be able to foster relationships and promote collaboration across numerous subordinate commanders with highly demanding missions and operational obligations. While experience in an operational environment is preferred, it is not required to apply. Assignment may entail travel and training opportunities, consistent with the roles/responsibilities as a member of the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate.

- TS/SCI eligibility <u>is</u> required for ADOS Orders to MARFORSOC. However, TS/SCI eligibility <u>is not</u> required to screen/apply.
